INDCAT ONLINE UNION CATALOGUE OF INFLIBNET CENTRE, UGC

> Radhamadha College Library as a part of Indcat Programme of Inflibnet

IndCat is a unified Online Library Catalogues of books, theses and journals available in major university libraries in India. This union database is very useful, which contains bibliographic description, location and holdings of information for books, journals and theses in all subject areas available in different university libraries across country. A Web-based interface is designed to provide easy access to the merged catalogues. The IndCat is a major source of bibliographic information that can be used for inter-library loan, collections development as well as for copy cataloguing and retro-conversion of bibliographic records. The IndCat consists of three major components (Books, Theses and Serials) available in open



access to users and librarians through web http://indcat.inflibnet.ac.in. interface IndCat Book Database Currently 1,07,06,459 Unique Records with 1,37,60,998 holding details of 197 Indian Universities, Theses Database has 4,41,003 Unique Ph.D. Records of 444 Universities, Serial Database has 35,234 Records of 229 Institutions.

Features and functionalities of IndCat:

- Open access to India's largest bibliographic databases across all major disciplines including Science & Technology, Social Sciences and Arts & Humanities.
- Supports simple, advanced search features i.e. records can be searched by author, title, subject heading, place of publication, publishers and year or combination of these parameters;
- SOLR-indexed based faceted search; facilitates resource sharing amongst participating universities and beyond through online copy-cataloguing and downloading bibliographic records;
- Serves as a virtual catalogue for universities and colleges by restricting the search to a single university;
- By default, a typical search covers entire union catalogue; searches can also be restricted to a group of universities or universities in a state;
- Serves as a backup for university libraries for their holdings;
- Links to full-text theses in Shodhganga.

ROLE OF ASSAM COLLEGE LIBRARIANS' ASSOCIATION IN EDUCATION DURING COVID 19 PANDEMIC

> Participation of Radhamadhab College Library

Assam College Librarians' Association (ACLA) is a state level premier association of librarians established in 1973. It represents those who work in or advocate for college libraries of Assam. ACLA is committed to the cause of college library movement and development in Assam and is working whole heartedly for the academic and social status of the college librarians and also for the development of the lbrary profession. Ever since its inception, ACLA has been doing its utmost for the cause of education by adopting a holistic approach towards improving the educational scenario at UG level in the state. During the pandemic period, it has established the real potentialities of library professionals not only in Assam but in entire India through different activities. ACLA with different collaborated institutions in Maharashtra, Kerala and other parts of India to organize various workshops, training and online sessions. An Online Training on E-Content Creation and E-Learning through MOOCs organized by the association in collaboration with Department of Library and Information Science, Gauhati University in June, 2020 with eminent resource persons from INFLIBNET Centre, U.G.C. Also, it is looking after the Digital Library Project in every college, reformation of Library Committee, introduction of Library Science at UG level, etc.

ACLA has conducted online training sessions on different modules of SOUL for the college librarians of Assam. The different colleges in Assam organized Webinars on Online Educational Resources with the support of ACLA. Radhamadhab College too organized an Online Session on "Use of Online Resources" in collaboration with the association. ACLA has also collaborated with universities and ACTA to organize different types of online programmes during the period. ACLA has been invited by Mission Director, SSA inputs in NEP 2020 and also to highlight the role of libraries in NEP. Librarians of different institutions of Assam were members of policy implementation committee of NEP 2020 | Assam. ACLA has submitted a memorandum to the government for provincialization of the posts of provincialized Librarians in earlier accordingly the government has accepted the proposal and granted the same. Recently, ACLA has taken a very important step to include the college libraries of Assam in the IndCat Programme of INFLIBNET, UGC by becoming the second state in India (after Gujarat) to participate in the development of this great union database.



10. Participation in Online Workshops of INFLIBNET, UGC:



The library participated in a one-day online training on SOUL 3.0 (Library Management Software developed by INFLIBNET, UGC) on 13/05/2020 and Serial Control Module of SOUL 2.0 on 17/05/2020 organized by INFLIBNET in collaboration with Assam College Librarians' Association (ACLA) with the Scientists from INFLIBNET as resource persons. It may be mentioned here that the college library is using the SOUL 2.0 version and is performing all the online operations of the library through this software and will be upgrading the software to SOUL 3.0 version soon

11. IndCat Programme of UGC - Submission of SOUL database in MARC 21 format and SOUL data backup:

As already mentioned, the college has participated in the IndCat Union Catalogue of Inflibnet, UGC, under which the Bibliographic data of library software SOUL 2.0 in MARC 21 format was submitted on 13/09/2019. Accordingly in subsequent time as asked by the Director, Inflibnet and communicated to us by ACLA, the SOUL data backup (database of records) was submitted on 23/12/2020 for finalization of the work.

12. Upgradation of SOUL from version 5.0 to 12.0:

The library has recently upgraded its library management software (SOUL 2.0) to the latest version on 29/12/2020 with technical assistance from the SOUL Centre, Inflibnet, Ahmedabad as a result of which some new modules and facilities have been introduced. It will enable the library to execute the different computerized functions in a smooth manner.
