Presently, she is the Director, Department of Culture, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. Also there are other outstanding women scientist in India like Dr. Janaki Ammal, Prof. Ashima Chatterjee, Prof. Anandibai Joshi, Prof Kasturi Dutta, Dr. Such Bhargava, Prof. Sipra and others. There are thousands of females working as Librarians in India, but only few names has been highlighted here. These Librarians have worked hard to become the best that they can be, contributing immensely to the development of the subject for the cause of mankind so as to aspire all the female Librarians to get in spiration and motivation to work dedicatedly.

5. Celebration of National Librarians' Day:







The college has participated in the IndCat Union Catalogue of Inflibnet, UGC, under which the Bibliographic data of library software SOUL 2.0 in MARC 21 format was submitted on 13/09/2019.

Accordingly in subsequent time as asked by the Director, Inflibnet and communicated to us by ACLA, the SOUL data backup (database of records) was submitted on 23/12/2020 for finalization of the work.

14. Upgradation of SOUL to 3.0:
